

Start on east side of Mayo Park. Fantastical Fruit Walk across Mayo Park bridge. Blue Heron (2016 Art4Trails)

Return across bridge. Sunrise Sunset (2016 Art4Trails)

Walk north to Silver Lake Station. **Perfect Canoe**Walk south to Riverwalk behind Government Center.

Return to Mayo Park.
